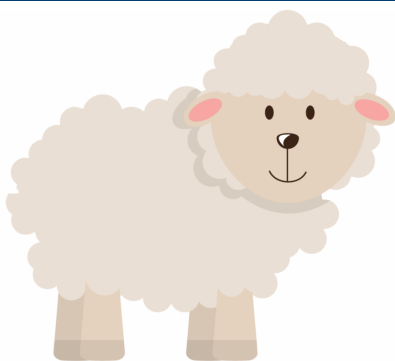

3	We have Three Bungalows that provide a home for people with complex disabilities
4	We help all those in need. They provide food parcels, advice and English classes as well as helping people find work. We have as many projects like the colours of the rainbow
5	We work in the heart of Birmingham (near the Cathedral) to help refugees with food and friendship
6	We are a home for older people and people with dementia. Like St Joseph, we have care at the heart of our work.
7	We have flats for people who need our support in the community.
8	We are a small project house that has become a home for 3 refugees.
9	We are an independent service that is their women and families as they change their lives.
10	We work with children and their families in schools to help them achieve.
11	We might work to stop older people who are lonely but at heart everyone is young
12	We are a project that brings together a home, community support and special skills to help one family of refugees in Oxford
13	Like our namesake, Mount Tabor we help homeless guests transform their lives.

 - I donated to the Good Shepherd Appeal

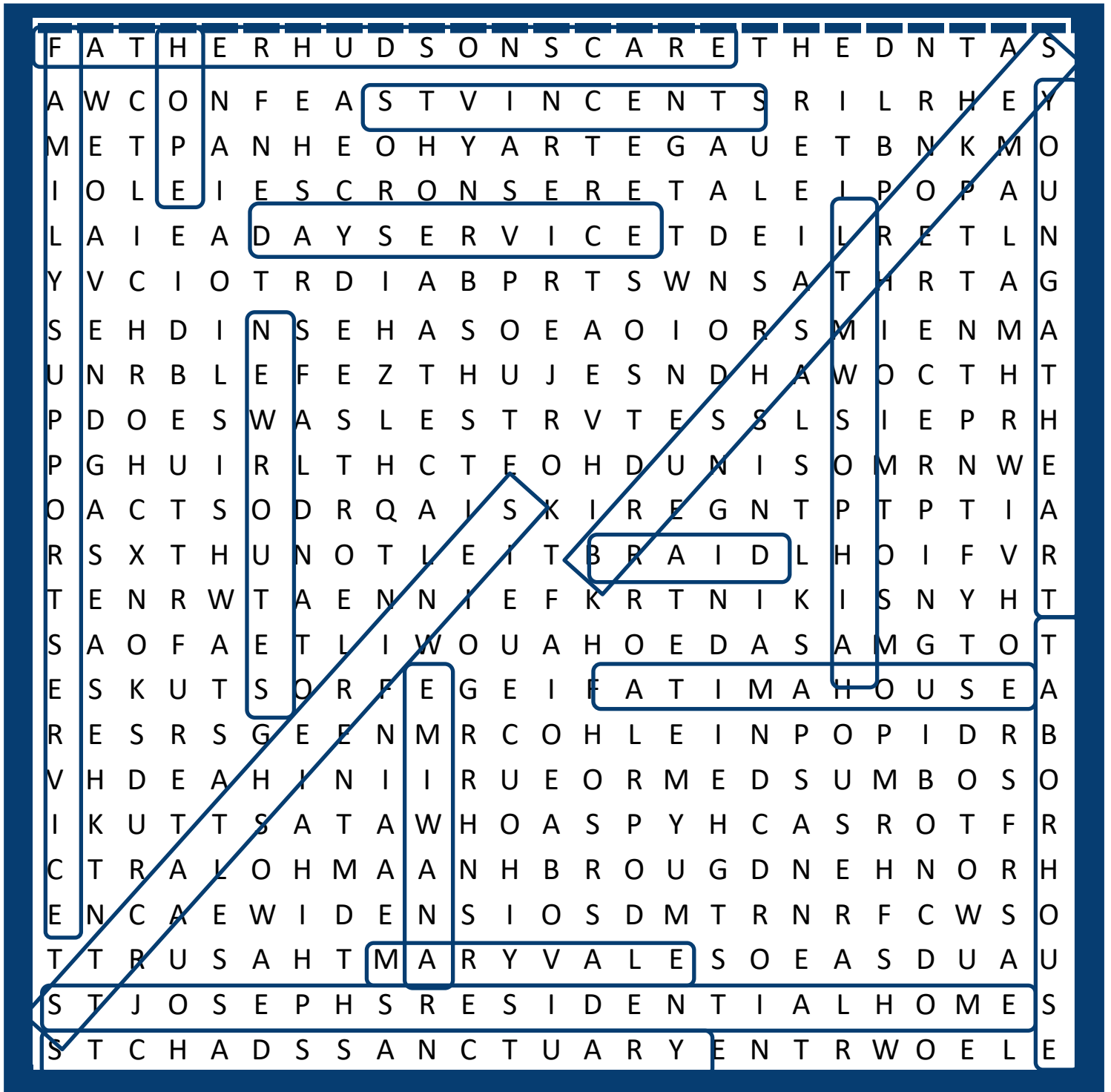
